Recycled solid surface

Durat is a unique, sustainable solid surface material which contains 30 % recycled post-industrial plastic and is 100 % recyclable.

- Durat is very durable with a long lifecycle.
- Durat collects and recycles up to 50t of plastic waste every year. The use of post-industrial plastic replaces the use of an equivalent quantity of virgin raw materials.
- Durat recycles 100 % of off-cuts and material waste generated in production. The off-cuts are granulated and used in manufacturing new material.
- Durat products can be easily upcycled.
- Durat is a safe material, it is VOC-emission free (M1 standard), it's food safe.
- The use of Durat as a building material contributes to the LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) rating system for buildings.
- Durat is manufactured using 100 % renewable electricity, the origin of which has been certified in accordance with the Guarantee of Origin system.

Responsibility

The company is committed to developing its business transparently and in accordance with the goals of circular economy. Durat's guiding principle is to reduce its ecological impact and the use of virgin raw materials, reuse and recycle resources as efficiently as possible.

Durat redeems all used Durat furniture, restores and resells them. We sell these upcycled, second cycle products under the brand of Durat Circular. Durat also buys back off-cuts from its customers' fabrication.
